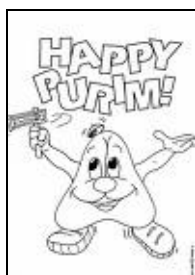

OUR SCHOOL TZEDAKAH MONEY - Where Does it Go?

Children learn about giving *tzedakah* by putting the coins in the *tzedakah* box.
